

Northwood Vet Service, LLC Surgery/Dental Required Pre-anesthetic Screening

These tests are similar to those that your physician would order were you to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests will serve as a reference value for future use if your pet should become ill. These tests are required if your pet is over the age of 7 years and undergoing anesthesia.

Complete Blood Count: Analyzes immune status (screens for infection, anemia, and the presence of adequate platelets).

Chemistry: Analyzes liver and kidney values, blood glucose, blood protein levels, and electrolytes.
IV Catheter and Fluid Therapy: Helps to maintain hydration and blood pressure during anesthesia and aids in a quicker and smoother recovery after procedure.
Dental X-rays: Dental x-rays allow us to evaluate dental health under the gumline. Large periodontal pockets, missing or fractured teeth would cause us to recommend dental x-rays to guide us with our plan of care for your pets mouth. The cost is \$10.00 per x-ray and a maximum cost of \$50.00 for full mouth x-rays. Complicated extractions WILL NOT be performed without x-rays.
Procedure: <u>EXTENT OF SERVICES DESIRED:</u> (NOTE: Dental extractions, if applicable, will result in an additional fee; the cost is \$3.00 per minute.)
Other than emergencies: If I CANNOT be reached by phone and, in the veterinarian's professional judgement, unforeseen procedures are deemed necessary and desirable. (Check one below):
I authorize you to proceed with any necessary X-rays, but please call for my consent on any possible extractions/procedures.
I authorize you to proceed with any necessary extractions/procedures and X-rays.
I do not authorize any unforeseen extractions or procedures without my consent.
In an emergency: Northwood Veterinary Service doctors and staff will stabilize your pet and call you for further authorization.

Comments/concerns:
Costs include surgery or standard dental procedure, anesthesia, hospitalization and pain medications. It also covers a general re-exam with a doctor, any additional medications needed at the re-exam are NOT covered. They DO NOT include follow-up care or treatment of any possible complications which include but are not limited to infection, suture reaction, suture line dehiscence, anesthetic complications, repair or implant failure and arthritis formation.
I am aware that a referral for hospitalization to a 24-hour critical care hospital is an option and I have elected to have my pet treated at Northwood Veterinary Service. I am aware that my pet will be unattended during the overnight hours. However, every precaution will be taken to ensure that my pet will receive the treatement and medication prescribed. If my pet's condition is unstable and very serious, I understand that referral to a 24-hour critical care hospital is highly recommended as it is against medical advice to have my pet unmonitored overnight.
I, the undersigned owner or agent of the owner of the pet identified above, certify that I am over eighteen (18) years of age. I hereby consent and authorize Northwood Veterinary Service to receive, prescribe for, treat and/or operate on the above named animal. Northwood Veterinary Service is to use all reasonable precautions against injury, escape, or loss of the animal, but will NOT be liable or responsible, in any manner or circumstances, as a result of the care, treatment, or safe keeping of the animal named above.
